



## Scotus Central Catholic High School COVID-19 Basketball Event Guidelines

All procedures have been developed using current directed health measures (DHM) and NSAA mandates and guidelines. The following are expectations at Scotus Central Catholic home events. When we visit other schools, they may have different guidelines. Scotus Central Catholic teams, coaches, and fans are expected to comply with those expectations. All protocols are subject to change. Please check for updates as the season progresses.

### Screening Procedures

- We ask that families screen for COVID-19 symptoms at home.
- If you answer yes to any of the following questions, Scotus Central Catholic asks you not attend the activity.
- Questions for screening process should include:
  - ◆ 1. Have you been in contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19?
  - ◆ 2. Have you recently traveled internationally within the last 14 days?
  - ◆ 3. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 or are pending results of COVID-19 testing?
  - ◆ 4. Do you have the following symptoms? - Fever over 100.4, dry cough, shortness of breath/difficulty of breathing, loss of taste or smell.
  - ◆ 5. Do you have two of the following symptoms? - Chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.

### Entrance and Exit Strategies

- Parking is located on east, north and west sides of Scotus Central Catholic.
- Gymnasium entrance is located on the north side of the building.
- Masks are required when attending Scotus Central Catholic activities.
- Tickets will be required for admission to all levels of Scotus Central Catholic basketball games, due to current capacity limits.
- Paid admission is required from all fans in addition to a ticket.
- Fans are encouraged to leave the facility immediately following the conclusion of the game. **Once your child's game is over, family members are asked to exit the facility.** Visiting fans in the Dowd Activity Center will be asked to use the west doors to exit. Home fans in the Dowd Activity Center will be asked to exit the gym through the east doors.



### **Capacity/Occupancy**

- Fan attendance for all indoor extracurricular activities is limited to household members of participants only.
- The current DHM requires capacity to be capped at 25%. Two tickets per roster player will be distributed for all fans.
- **Six feet of separation** between parties is required at all activities.
- Families are encouraged to sit together.
- Bleacher seats will be marked to indicate where fans may sit.
- Scotus Central Catholic fans will sit on the north side of the Dowd Activity Center, visiting fans will be on the south side of the Dowd Activity Center.

### **Restrooms and Concessions**

- Currently the concession stand will be closed.
- There is a vending machine available at the north entrance.
- Scotus Central Catholic fans will use the restrooms on the east side of the building near the Media Center. Visiting fans will use the restrooms south of the concessions on the west side of the building.
- Facilities will be sanitized before and after events.

### **Game Procedures**

- All spectators and coaches must wear masks.
- Players must wear a mask when not warming up or competing.
- Officials are asked to wear a mask when entering and exiting the facility. They are not required to wear a mask during the game.
- Masks are required when traveling on a school vehicle.
- Scotus Central Catholic will provide a water jug for both teams.
- Players and fans should not congregate on the court following the game.
- Under current conditions, the pep band will not perform.
- Team meals must be distributed outside the facility.
- Drinking fountains will not be available, water bottle fillers are available.
