OCTOBER

- Heisman High School Scholarship
 - National scholarship; 3.0+ GPA
 - Due Oct. 18th



NOVEMBER

- American Legion Oratorical Contest Scholarship
 - Multi-step process
 - Part one due Nov. 6th
- Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship
 - National; awards 500 scholarships to highest-rated applicants
 - Due Nov. 14th
- National Honor Society Scholarship
 - National; must be a member of NHS
 - Due Nov. 30th



FEBURARY

- Susan Thompson Buffett Scholarship
 - Students planning to attend a public Nebraska college
 - Based on: financial need, academic merit, short answer, and letters of recommendation.
 - Due Feb. 1st
- NE Elks Association Vocational Scholarship
 - Students pursuing a 2-year vocational study at a community college or other 2-year program.
 - Due Feb. 15th
- Past Exalted Ruler's Scholarship
 - Need-based
 - Due Feb. 15th
- NE Elks Association Golf Scholarship
 - Must have played for Scotus golf team and plan to play in college
 - Due Feb. 15th
